

LIVING VILLAGE

The Choctaw Living Village's mound is inspired by Nvnih Waiya – the Choctaw ceremonial mound in Mississippi. This mound illustrates the monumental and sophisticated architectural relationship between the Choctaw people and Mother Earth. Guests can walk near the mound as they explore Choctaw dwellings, interact with village demonstrations and participate in various activities, including stickball, basketry and agriculture.
